To access all online classes, a computer such as a Chromebook, Mac, or Windows PC is required.

Technology Requirements for all classes – additional requirements for select classes listed below	
Internet Connectivity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High speed internet connection - DSL or Cable internet service • 1.5Mbps download/upload speed (per user)
Hardware	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computer: Chromebook, Mac, or Windows PC (tablets can work, but are not recommended) • Monitor/Display, keyboard, mouse/trackpad, speakers, microphone, and webcam • Optional but recommended: headset with microphone and printer
Class Access	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classes will be accessed through Google Classroom and conducted live via Google Meet and/or Zoom (information will be emailed prior to the start of classes) • Direct links to Google Meet or Zoom will only be posted in Google Classroom • See below for information on Google accounts

Hardware	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Computer: Chromebook, Mac, or Windows PC • Other devices in addition to computer: iPhone or iPad • Monitor/Display, keyboard, mouse/trackpad, speakers, microphone, and webcam • Optional but recommended: headset with microphone and printer
Software	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Video Production requires the use of iMovie, which is an Apple product. An iPad or iPhone <u>in addition to a computer</u> is required. If you only have an Android device, please let the teacher know and they will work with you on alternative editing software.
