The following are agreed upon responsibilities that we, as partners, will carry out to support the school musical. Break a leg!

**Student Commitment - I agree to carry out the following responsibilities to the best of my ability:**

- I will be prepared for Auditions and submit via FlipGrid by the due date
- The casting of this show is determined by the needs of the show, the talent potential, and the evidence of student commitment. The casting team will make final decisions regarding the cast.
- Upon being cast in the show, I accept the show as a primary commitment for the rehearsal and performance period.
- I will attend all the rehearsals except for serious illness or death in the family. I will let the Director know of any ongoing conflicts.
- I will exhibit appropriate behavior during rehearsal, and will respect the "3 strikes" rules of conduct.
- I will prepare for rehearsals by learning all lines and choreography and rehearsing those on my own time, in addition to regular rehearsals.
- I am expected to maintain good academic standings and keep up with my school work.
- I assume responsibility for care of all scripts, costumes, props, and tools used. I may be asked to provide the base parts of my costume (such as pants, t-shirt, tights, socks and shoes)
- I will respect all parent volunteers and teachers by listening to and following all directions.
- If my role is not being rehearsed, I will remain in the MPR, sit quietly, complete homework, and wait for directions.

**Family/Parent Commitment - I agree to carry out the following responsibilities:**

- Return this Commitment Form on the first day of rehearsal, with all information completed and signed
- I understand that the casting of this show is determined by the needs of the show, the talent potential, and the evidence of student commitment. The casting team will make final decisions regarding the cast.
- Insure my child attends all rehearsals on time & pick up my child on time after each rehearsal
- In the event of illness, I will contact the Check-In person BEFORE rehearsal begins.
- Use the Musical Shutterfly website to keep myself informed of any updates or schedule changes
- Use the Remind App to use as our communication tool for tardies, absences, etc.
- I may be asked to provide base parts of my student's costume (pants, t-shirt, tights, socks, shoes).
